The organization they formed the Palmetto Ballroom Dance Club (PBDC) celebrated its 20th anniversary October 13 with a gala anniversary dance at the Leatherman Senior Center in Florence.

The black tie optional event featured performances and lessons by dance professionals Karolina Spziech and Max Maleschko, from Charlotte, NC, along with a delicious buffet dinner and an evening of dancing and fellowship for the more than 60 members and guests in attendance. Many former club members and officers returned to Florence to attend.
